

CRITERIA SPECIFIC TO MIDWIFERY PROGRAM

These program criteria are for undergraduate graduates who will graduate with the title of "MIDWIFE" after completing the midwifery department. Due to the structure of the education program at the undergraduate level, midwives are in direct contact with individuals and women, pregnant women and newborns; Because he/she is a health professional who plays a direct role in health promotion and protection; basic medical education, all approaches for the protection and improvement of health, profession-specific evaluations and practices, current legislation and practices for social health should be provided with sufficient content, equipment and practical application opportunities

- The ability to make the necessary evaluations and applications in order to provide the care of women during pregnancy, childbirth and postpartum period,
- The ability to take care of the newborn,
- The ability to perform vaginal delivery under his own responsibility and to have a breech delivery in emergency situations,
- To be able to distinguish deviations from normal; the ability to diagnose risky situations and make necessary interventions
- Ability to take an active role in research and project studies
- Ability to work in collaboration with women and society,
- The ability to follow developments in the field of midwifery towards changing and diversifying needs and to contribute to the formation of appropriate health policies
- The ability to work effectively, efficiently and in line with ethical principles with other healthcare professionals and other disciplines they interact with.
